Alfred H. Jones, Jr., of Chalfont, PA died on Monday, December 2, 2024, at Doylestown Hospital. He was 81.

He was the beloved husband of 57 years to Mary Lou (Peck) Jones.

Born in Philadelphia, PA, he was the son of the late Alfred H. Jones and Grace Erichson Jones.

Al was a member of the National Society Sons of the American Revolution, Historical Society of Hilltown Township, Harleysville/Souderton Game, Fish, and Forestry Association, and Lookaway Golf Club. He originated the Lookaway trap shooting registry and granted

membership into the Republican Senatorial Inner Circle.

Al was a reserved commissioned officer in the United States Army and the Pennsylvania National Guard. In 1961 he graduated from North Penn High School and went on to attend Ursinus College. Al was the Founder, CEO and President of Quaker City International, and was a member of the First Board of Directors of Starnet Cooperative.
